adopting a resolution making application to the state bond commission for approval to
issue not exceeding \$3,313,000 of sewer revenue bonds, series 2016 and providing for
interim financing in connection with the construction of a portion of the project being

thereto.

carried, adopting the millage rates for the tax year 2015.

declaring the 2003 Chevy C1500 pickup truck in the Police Department as surplus.

adopting a resolution authorizing the Mayor to accept the donation of property from the
City of Carencro.

2015.
