A motion was offered by Taylor Mencacci, seconded by Guy Nerren and duly carried, authorizing Sellers & Associates to submit a Capital Outlay Application to the State of Louisiana for Sewer Extension along the south side of the La Highway 14 Bypass going east from Myrtle Street and south on Old Railroad Street.

A motion was offered by Robert Vincent, seconded by Robert Domingues and duly carried, authorizing Sellers & Associates to resubmit a grant application through the FEMA 2018 Flood Mitigation Assistance Program for the elevation of structures at the Erath Housing Authority.

A motion was offered by Taylor Mencacci, seconded by Robert Domingues and duly carried, adopting an Ordinance granting Centerpoint Energy Resources Corp., D/B/A Centerpoint Energy Louisiana Gas, the right to construct, install, operate and maintain facilities for the transportation distribution and sale of gas in the municipality and, for such purposes, to use and excavate in the public highways, streets, sidewalks, alleys, squares, commons, grounds, and other publicly owned areas and levying a franchise (privilege) tax for that purpose.

A motion was offered by Robert Domingues, seconded by Taylor Mencacci and duly carried, authorizing DOTD to prepare an agreement for the right sizing program of Broadway Street.

A motion was offered by Taylor Mencacci, seconded by Guy Nerren and duly carried, adopting the September budget-to-actual financial reports.
